

# **Setting Up Panopto for Your Course**

Panopto is a web-based lecture capture service that provides the ability to combine audio and screen capture in a single recording. To use the Panopto service, you must first set it up for each course through your CoursePlus class site\*. This process will create a designated folder, linked directly to your class site in the Resources navigation menu available to students and faculty. Your Panopto recordings will be saved automatically to this folder, as long as you're signed into the service. Additionally, this folder can be used to archive other video files that are uploaded manually.

\*IMPORTANT: To allow for processing and set up operations to complete, it is recommended that you set up Panopto at least one day before the first day of class. By default, the Panopto course folder permissions are limited to the course staff and registered students, with faculty receiving "creator" privileges.

When you are ready to record with Panopto from your laptop or classroom computer, you will sign into the <u>Panopto website</u> or app installed on your computer.

# **Setting Up Panopto in CoursePlus**

To set up Panopto for a course, go to the main Faculty Tools page in your CoursePlus course site and click on the Panopto Recordings link within the Content Tools group.

The first time you click on it, you will see a screen containing an overview of Panopto. You must select the button reading, "Yes, I want to use Panopto to record my class" to begin the setup process.

### Panopto Recordings


Panopto is a lecture capture recording system used throughout the University. Panopto will record the audio from a classroom podium and the screen on the classroom computer where Panopto is running. It can also be used to store recordings of Zoom sessions. BSPH IT offers training and guidance for using Panopto.

Verify the course information on the form that appears before using the button to "Send Your Request to BSPH IT". Upon successful submission, a message will be displayed stating that the link to Panopto recordings for your course will appear in CoursePlus in a few hours.



Once your Panopto course folder has been created, the Panopto Recordings page can be navigated to from the Resources drop-down menu on the horizontal navigation bar across your course site.



The page will now have a direct link to the folder set up specifically for that class offering.

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
