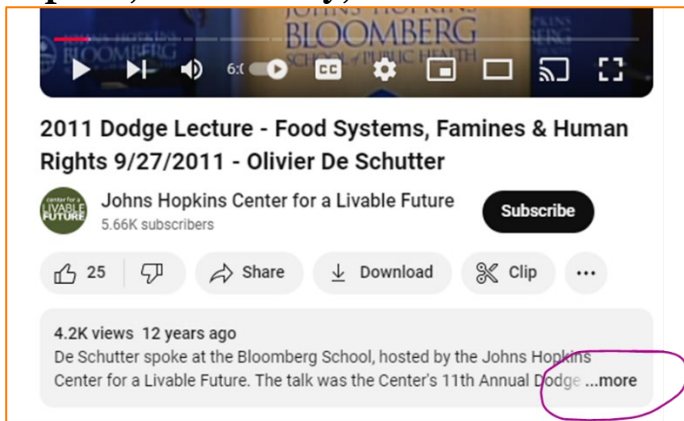


# Accessing Transcripts for YouTube Videos

YouTube videos with captions (whether automatically generated or not) should have transcripts available. These are accessed by taking the following steps, listed separately for a web browser and the mobile app.

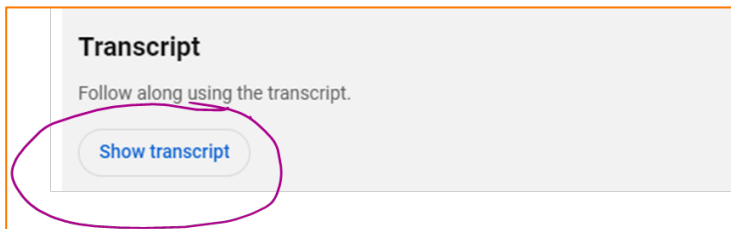
## Visiting the YouTube Website in your Web Browser

1. **Expand, if necessary, details under the video in the default display.**

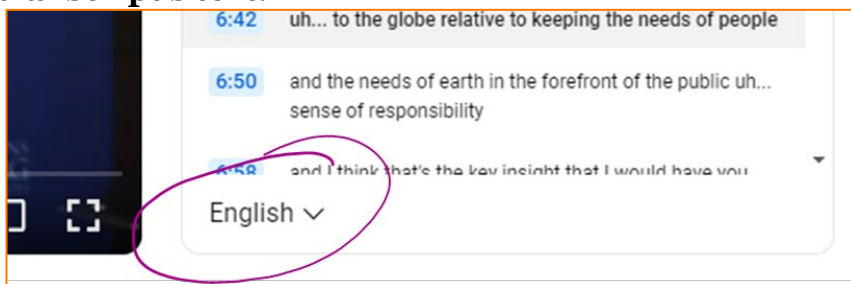


2. **Navigate to the bottom of the details section and click “Show Transcript” under the Transcript heading.**

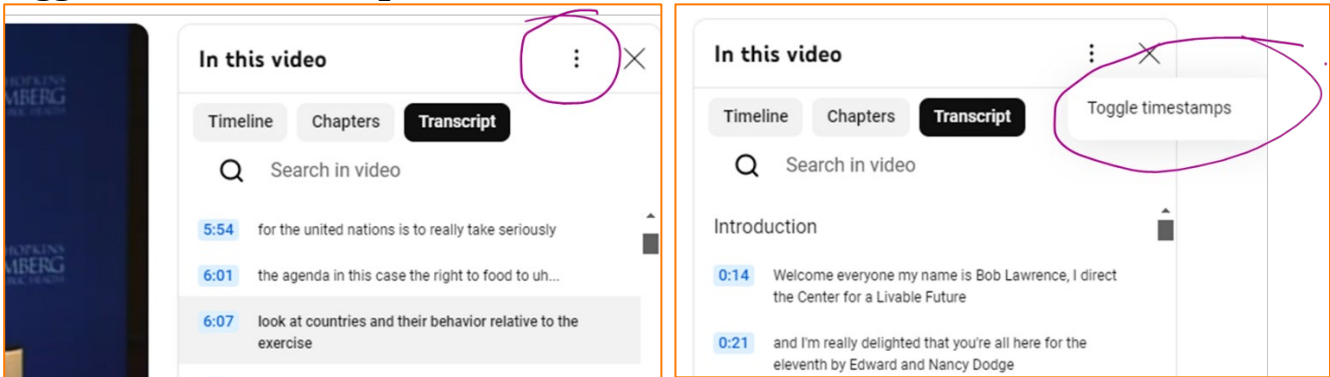
This displays the transcript along the right side of the video. The page will refocus to make the transcript the active component on your browser’s display.



3. **[Optional] Select the language of the displayed transcript at the bottom of the transcript’s text.**

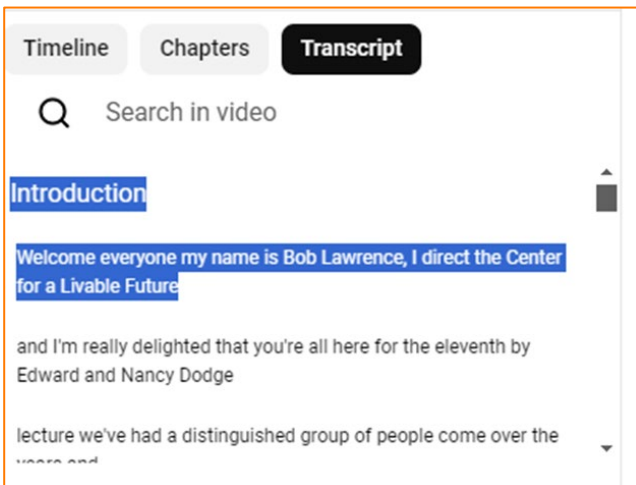


4. [Optional] Near the displayed transcript, expand the menu to display the option toggle off the timestamps.



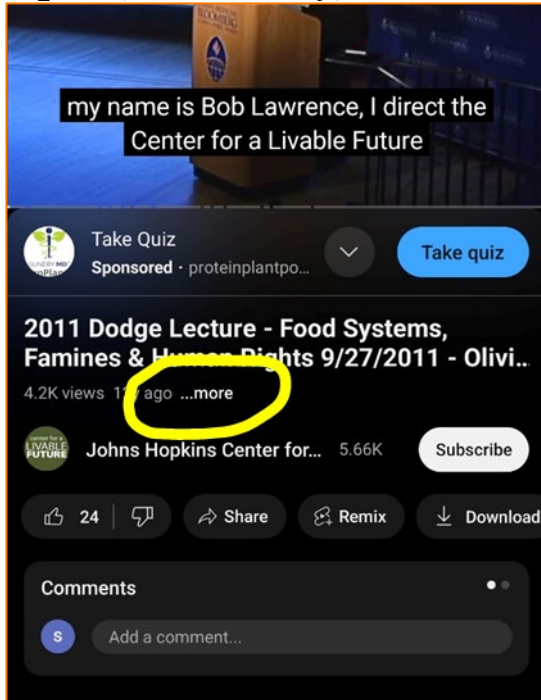
5. [Optional] Insert your cursor inside the displayed transcript and select its text to copy and paste it into a text document.

There is no option to download the transcript. If you want to save it separately from the YouTube website, you must copy and paste it into your own text editor such as Microsoft Word.



## Using the YouTube App on Your Mobile Device

1. Expand, if necessary, details under the video in the default display.



2. Navigate to the bottom of the details section and click “Show Transcript” under the Transcript heading.

This displays the transcript underneath the video.
