About the 2026 BSPH CTL PowerPoint Template for Public Health Academics

File Format

The PowerPoint (*.pptx) standard file type was selected as the format for distributing the updated templates. **Content authors and editors should always start with one of our templates and select “Save As” with a different name before beginning their edits.**

Each template contains fourteen slides by default. Color accents are the only difference between the four files. After saving the chosen PowerPoint template with a different filename, these slides can be used or deleted. New slides, including any other layouts from the [slide master](#), can be added.

Accessibility

The CTL Templates are all digitally accessible. When the accessible files are used as a starting point, maintaining accessibility is the responsibility of the author and any editors. Using them as designed,

including using the original placeholders and reading order, will help maintain accessibility. The guidelines for creating [Universally Accessible Materials: Expectations of Faculty](#) should be followed. Additional resources to help maintain accessibility, specific to our template, include:

Fonts

The fonts used in the CTL templates are standard types installed by default with Microsoft Office 365. While different from [those fonts shared by BSPH External Affairs](#), our choices are similar in style.

The fonts in our templates were made with consideration to both the legibility of academic content (most specifically, numbers and italicized text) and the ease of use for our faculty teams. **When using our PowerPoint templates, you are encouraged to keep the font (typeface) to maintain the branding “feel” of the School while also supporting clarity and accessibility.**
